Camp Description

The Bryce Resort Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) camp will be taught in two separate age classes:

Campers aged 6-9 will participate in the Arts & Sciences curriculum with a focus on the Arts and Nature based activity program with an additional emphasis on the environmental sciences.

Campers aged 10-14 will participate in a program curriculum focused more on the traditional Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math (STEM) oriented activities. Learning activities will be hands-on, connected to our local surroundings, and fun focused. Our goal is to provide a safe and interactive environment that will allow the participants to learn new skills and begin to understand the educational pathways behind STEAM careers. Camper creativity, resourcefulness and imagination will be highly encouraged. Each camp will also have time for outdoor recreation and end the day with water sports activities (weather permitting.)

Highlights of our Bryce Resort STEAM program include:

- Appropriate grouping with campers of similar age levels and age appropriate learning objectives and Small group instruction with emphasis on hands on experiments and environmental learning
- Exploring the basic principles of STEAM and discover how fun and fascinating STEAM can be

Items to Bring to Camp

- Students must wear sport specific footwear (sneakers, hiking boots, etc.)
- Lunch in a cooler and Snacks: one before lunch, one for after lunch (**NO PEANUT BUTTER or NUTS**)
- Water bottle(s) and Swimsuit & Towel
- Label all items and Do NOT bring electronics, cash or any other objects that could be lost or go missing. It is not the responsibility of the camp or Bryce Resort if this happens.
